CARE & MAINTENANCE

Oliveri uses the highest sanitary grade acrylic, however naked flames, cigarettes or strong chemicals will damage the bath and must be avoided and/or removed immediately. To preserve the high gloss acrylic surface, note the following:

When filling the bath, start with cold water to allow the bath to gradually adapt to the changing temperature. After using your bath, clean with a soft cloth and warm soapy water to clean away any oils or soap, to prevent tide marks and preserve the high-gloss surface. Clean using warm soapy water and only mild liquid detergents. Do not use powders, pastes, creams, chemicals, window cleaning sprays or abrasive cleaners.

Any scratches that do occur can be removed with a fine polish like Brasso.

WARRANTY

We provide the following warranty for products purchased in Australia or New Zealand from authorised Oliveri resellers for use in domestic residential (indoor) or commercial (indoor) installations (Products). Commercial installations include all non-residential installations including hotels, motels, gyms, clubs, factories, schools, hospitals, restaurants and aged care facilities. This warranty is in addition to our responsibility to customers under all other statutory and regulatory requirements. The applicable warranty period set out below (Warranty Period) starts at the original date of purchase.

We will (at our cost) either repair or replace (at our option) the Product at an equivalent value of the product purchased if it is discovered that the Product contains a material defect which arose during manufacture. We will pay the expense for shipment of the repaired or replaced Product to you. The warranty set out in the Warranty Statement above (other than sections 1(a)) is subject to the following conditions, and accordingly will not apply if: (a) The Product was not new as at the date of purchase or proof of purchase details (such as invoice, receipt or transaction record) are

- (b) There is a failure to follow installation instructions, evidence cannot be provided that the Product was installed by a licensed plumber or the Product is used other than in accordance with product specifications. This includes operating conditions specified for temperature and pressure.



This Oliveri bath is manufactured to Australian Standard AS 1172.5:2019

A CAUTION

Risk of personal injury. Freestanding baths are heavy. Get help when lifting or moving. Be sure to use proper tools and always wear personal safety devices for your protection.

IMPORTANT

This bath is supplied with an integrated overflow system and pop-up waste pre-installed. However, the plumbing connection from bath overflow outlet to floor drain is not included.

- 1. Unpack the bath and check for any transit damage. **Do not install the bath if it is damaged.**
- 2. Position the bath in the desired location where it will be installed in the bathroom.
- 3. Check that the floor drain plumbing is suitably located for connection to the bath when in the desired location and that the location of the bath does not interfere with other bathroom fixtures.
- 4. Turn the height-adjustable feet to raise or lower the bath until the bath base is level and 3 5 mm above the finished floor surface.

IMPORTANT

Installing the bath shell directly onto the bath floor will place pressure on the outside wall of the bath and can crack the bath.

Ensure there is a gap of 3 - 5 mm between the bath shell and the floor.

Installing the bath level is important to make sure all the water drains effectively to the waste outlet.


- 5. Raise the bath off the floor by propping it up onto timber blocks positioned at either end of the bath.
- 6. Connect the pre-installed bath overflow waste outlet to the floor drain outlet. We recommend using a flexible hose connector (not included). Please adhere to the manufacturer's instructions and all relevant sections of the plumbing standard AS/NZ 3500. Ensure the flexible connector is cut to the correct length for easier installation and to prevent drainage issues.
- 7. Carefully remove the timber blocks and use a spirit level to re-check that the bath is level with the floor and 3 5 mm above the surface. Adjust feet as necessary.
- 8. Before finishing the installation and securing the bath in position, water test for leaks and proper drainage.

IMPORTANT

Fill the bath with water and check that the water flows easily to the waste outlet.


NOTE: A small amount of water may pool due to surface tension.

- 9. Carefully tilt the bath backward and apply a neutral-cure silicone adhesive to each of the bath feet. Lower the bath back into its final position.
- 10. Apply a thick bead of neutral-cure silicon sealant around the bath base and the finished floor ensuring that a watertight seal is formed. Allow sealant to set for 24 hours before using the bath.
